2021 ANNUAL GOLF PASS AGREEMENT

This is an Annual Agreement for an Annual Golf Pass between the Heather Ridge Golf Course and the individual listed below. As a Golf Club at Heather Ridge Annual Pass holder, you agree to the following:

- 1. An Annual Golf Pass is extended only to the individual listed in the application.
- 2. All Pass holders are eligible to reserve individual tee times 10 days in advance.
- 3. All Pass holders are entitled to unlimited golf.
- 4. All Pass holders are entitled to one bucket of balls each day a round is played.
- 5. All Pass holders are required to check in at the pro shop 30 minutes prior to beginning play.
- 6. All Pass holders are required to abide by the the Golf Club at Heather Ridge Cart Rental Agreement and are required to sign for cart rental for each round.
- 7. All Pass holders must comply with the cancellation policy regarding tee times. Abuse of the advance tee time privilege may result in suspension of advance tee time privileges or a charge for those cancelled tee times.
- 8. All Pass holders are responsible for their conduct and the conduct of any guests.
- 9. All Pass holders and guests are required to adhere to all golf course policies and procedures.
- 10. Each golfer must have his/her own clubs.
- 11. Carts are designed for only two passengers.
- 12. During inclement weather, it may be necessary to close the golf course facility. This may include the golf course, putting green, and the driving range.
- 13. The Golf Club at Heather Ridge employs marshals who will keep play moving, assist patrons with information and enforce golf course policies.
- 14. Tournament play, including Men's Club, Ladies Club and outside tournaments, may be scheduled on any given day and time.
- 15. The Golf Club at Heather Ridge provides a restaurant where food and beverage may be purchased. No outside alcoholic beverages may be brought on to the premises. This is a violation of the State of Colorado liquor laws and may result in your removal from the golf course and possible prosecution.
- 16. The Golf Club at Heather Ridge reserves the right to adjust non-pass holder golf rates.
- 17. The "Cart path only next to Green and Tees" will be strictly enforced. If you violate this policy, you may be refused access to golf carts and the golf course.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Reserving a Tee Time (Policy) Reservations may be made up to 10 days in advance for Annual Pass holders and 7 days in advance for the Public by calling the Golf Shop at (303)755-3550 or booking online. Tee times may be canceled on-line, through the Pro Shop or through the Pro Shop answering service Ezlinks in Chicago.

Person making a tee time, is responsible for the number of players the tee time is reserved for. No Shows are subject to revocation of reservation privileges or full charge for the no shows.

You should cancel up to 24 hours in advance.

All fees are due upon arrival at course.

Cancellation Policy:

Tee time cancellation and/or changes to the booking must be made by phone at (303)755-3550, in person or via the tee time website at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled tee time. If a reservation or change to reservation is not cancelled by this time, future reservations will require prepayment or reservation privileges may be denied. Pass holder will be responsible to pay for any times they tee they fail to cancel that day.

Check-in Policy:

All players should be checked in 30 minutes prior to your scheduled tee time. Tee times are subject to be released to standby players if check-in time is not met.

Rain Check Policy:

During inclement weather conditions, cancellations will be accepted until the time of play. Rainy weather itself may not dictate the closing of the course. Course Management determines delays or closures of the golf course. Rain checks will be issued due to inclement weather. Refunds will not be issued.

Pace of Play Policy:

Heather Ridge maintains an aggressive pace-of-play policy in order to assure everyone's enjoyment of the game. If you cannot play the golf course in 4 hours or less, please consider reserving a tee-time during non-peak hours. While playing, if you fall a shot or hole behind the group in front of you, you may be given the opportunity to catch that group within a one-hole span. If you do not catch up with the group, your group may be moved forward, into position behind the group in front of you. Heather Ridge does everything possible to ensure an acceptable

pace-of-play; however, we do not guarantee that your round will conclude within a specific amount of time.

Dress Code:

Shirt and shoes must always be worn on the golf course. Appropriate golf attire is required. Shirts may not display vulgar words, obscene images or be contrary to the values of the golf course.

Shoes worn on the golf course must be appropriate for golf, as determined by the Course Professional or Golf Course Superintendent. Use of metal/ceramic spikes is prohibited.

Course Conditions:

It is always our goal to keep the course in top condition. At times, sound maintenance practices, such as aeration and top dressing, may inconvenience players or alter playing conditions. While we regret this, we know that is necessary within the over-all conditioning of the course. Aeration season at Heather Ridge is in the Spring and Fall.

Code of Conduct:

Please treat all associates and fellow golfers with the respect and consideration with which you expect to be treated.

Always Use of decent and proper language and behaviors. Swearing, vulgar language or gestures, throwing clubs, displaying poor conduct or behavior may disqualify your golf privileges at Heather Ridge Golf Course.

Replace divots, repair ball marks, rake bunkers and use of proper containers for garbage is required.

Obey all instruction signs on the golf course. Follow the "Cart path only next to Greens & Tees" will be strictly enforced.

Damaging greens, defacing or destroying club property will disqualify your golf privileges at Heather Ridge Golf Course.

An adult player must always accompany players 13 years of age and under.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may limit your access to golf carts and the golf course.
